



## Albert 'Al' S. Richter

May 17, 1925 - June 22, 2016

Albert "Al" S. Richter, 91 of Kearney, died Wednesday, June 22, 2016 at Good Samaritan Society in Ravenna. Funeral service will be 10:30 a.m. on June 24, 2016 at Zion Lutheran Church with Pastor James DeLoach officiating. Burial will be at the Kearney Cemetery. In lieu of flowers memorials are suggested to the Zion Lutheran Church. Al was born May 17, 1925 in South Euclid, Ohio to Arthur and Blanche (Bookman) Richter. He graduated from Brush High School in 1943. He enlisted in the Navy in 1943 and served in the Pacific Theater during World War II. After his discharge in 1945, Al returned to Cleveland and worked for Ohio National Bank. Al married Dorothy Holsing on May 3, 1947 in South Euclid, Ohio. He began working for Eaton Corporation in 1949. They moved to Kearney in 1969, to be the plant manager for Eaton's. In 1973 Al was transferred to Arkansas to help open another plant. They returned to Kearney in 1975, where he worked as plant manager until retiring in 1987. Al was a member of Zion Lutheran Church, Kearney V.F.W. Post #759, and the Kearney Country Club. During his retirement, he enjoyed golfing, gardening, cooking, and bowling. Al is survived by his wife Dorothy of Ravenna; son, Jeffrey Richter of Casper, WY, granddaughters Melissa Young of Aurora, NE Megan Richter of Lincoln, NE; grandson Daniel Richter and wife Kaci of Omaha, NE; 7 great grandchildren. Al was preceded in death by his daughter Linda Richter Nielsen, three brothers, and two sisters.
