Andersen on June 23, 1959 in Munich, Germany. Following his discharge, Al and Marilyn moved to Kearney where Al eventually owned and operated the Andersen Manufacturing Company. Al was a member of the Kearney Volunteer Fire Department, Rob Morris Masonic Lodge # 46 AF & AM, Tehama Shrine, Elks Lodge # 984 and a life member of PTA.
