She also enjoyed her sewing club, spending time with friends playing cards, holidays and special occasions with family. Alice raised eight children of her own and added several foster babies over the years until they found permanent homes. She and Bill started the Share America program in Sioux City that provided discounted groceries to area families in need.

Alice always considered Sioux City home and the family will be taking her home to her final resting place.

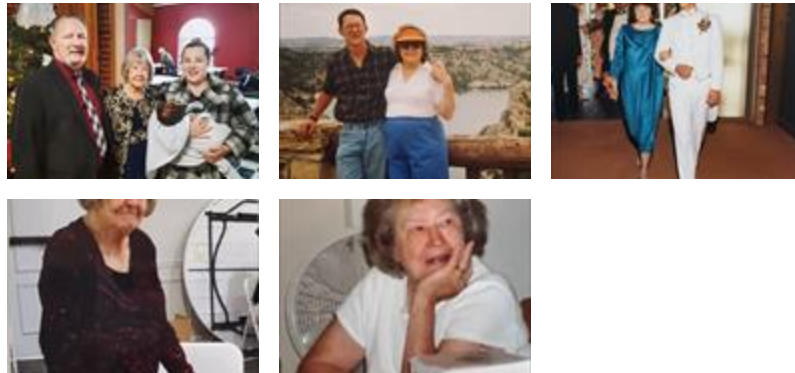
