Allen L. Greckel, age 74, of Kearney, passed away Thursday, February 13, 2020 at his home in Kearney. The family grew an abundance of trees, garden vegetables, raised many animals and enjoyed spending time outdoors. Allen loved Husker football, hunting and fishing at his parent's lake down the road and along the Elkhorn River, but most of all, spending time with family. Allen worked for the City of West Point for more than 30 years and later was employed at CHI

Health Good Samaritan Fitness Center in Kearney. After the children were grown, the couple moved to Yankton and Hot Springs, South Dakota, Reno, Nevada and back to Nebraska, where they lived in Kearney for the past 18 years.
