



## Amalia "Molly" O. Hanneman

Amalia "Molly" O. Hanneman, 88, of Kearney, passed away Monday, June 29, 2020 at St. John's – Good Samaritan Center in Kearney. Funeral services will be 10:00 a.m., July 3, 2020 at Countryside Christian Church with Pastor Ken Hutson officiating. Burial will follow the service at Fredericksburg Cemetery south of Minden. Visitation will be from 5:00 to 7:00 p.m., Thursday, July 2, 2020 at the funeral home and one hour prior to the service Friday at the church. Memorials are suggested to the family to be designated later.

Molly was born December 3, 1931 in Kearney to Magner and Viola (Stuthiet) Nielsen. She grew up south of Minden and graduated from Minden High School in 1951.
