Anna Lucille "Suz" Walker, 90, formerly of Kearney, NE, passed away on August 15, 2016, in Fort Collins, CO. Suz enjoyed entertaining family and friends and made everyone feel welcome in her home. Suz raised her six children with a kind heart, quick wit and indomitable spirit. She was a doting grandmother and great-grandmother and a caring and attentive aunt to her

many nieces and nephews.
