Antoni "Toni" J. Moreau, 90, of Kearney, died Tuesday, February 3, 2015 at St. John's Good Samaritan Center in Kearney. Mass of Christian Burial will be Monday, February 9, 2015 at 10:30 a.m. at St. James Catholic Church in Kearney. Father Art Faeser will celebrate and burial will follow at Kearney Cemetery. Military rites at graveside will be provided by the Kearney American Legion Post #52, the Kearney Veterans of Foreign Wars Post #759 and the Nebraska National Guard Funeral Honors Team. He began a career with the United States Post Office, after the war, that would span over 32 years. He married Dorene Peterson on June 17, 1946 in Kearney. After retirement from the Postal Service he sold real estate and also drove the bookmobile. Toni was involved with the Knights of Columbus, American Legion, NARFE and the

Letter Carriers Union. He was also a member of the St. James Catholic Church in Kearney.
