Ardis Bauer, age 92, of Amherst, passed away Monday, November 18, 2024 at St. Luke's in Kearney. For a short period of time, they lived in Kentucky, the District of Columbia, and many other places, but for the majority of their lives, they called Amherst home. Ardis would often comment that she was blessed to live north of Amherst and enjoyed the view on top of the hill where they lived. Ardis was a 4-H leader for both sewing and cooking. She was also a piano accompanist whenever anyone asked. She was an avid gardener and canned her produce, teaching many people this practice. Ardis was well known for her cooking prowess, especially her delicious dinner rolls. Ardis and Donald were

active members of the E-Free church in Pleasanton where they volunteered for Awanas. Later in life, as in their early years, they once again enjoyed traveling across the United States and parts of Europe.

Ardis is survived by her children: Russel and Margene (Pierce) Bauer; LeAnn (Bauer) and Virgil Kenney Jr.; Ronald Bauer; Leland and Edith (Holoubeck) Bauer all of Amherst, NE, and Troy and Kay (Heins) Bauer of Dallas Center, IA; fifteen grandchildren, fourteen great grandchildren.
