Arthur A. "Swede" Riessland, age 87, of Amherst died Thursday morning, November 18, 2010 at the Good Samaritan Center in Ravenna. Mass of Christian Burial will be Monday, November 22, 2010 at 10:30 a.m. at the St. Mary's Catholic Church in Pleasanton with Father Marty Egging officiating. Burial will be in the St. Mary's Catholic Cemetery in Pleasanton with military rites at the grave by the Leo & Clinton Krotz Post # 9481 of Pleasanton and the Navy Military Honor Squad. Visitation will be from 2:00 4:00 p.m. Sunday afternoon at the Horner Lieske McBride & Kuhl Funeral Home in Kearney and one hour prior to services Monday morning at the Church in Pleasanton. Swede was born December 1, 1922 on the family farm near Amherst to Fred and Gertrude (Ripp) Riessland. He was raised in the Amherst area and was a graduate of Amherst High School. Swede entered the service on February 12, 1943 and served as a Submariner in the U.S. Navy until he was discharged on January 26, 1946. Following his discharge, Swede returned to Amherst and on June 16, 1948 he married Margaret L. Shubert in Eddyville. Swede farmed and ranched in the Amherst/Pleasanton area until he retired in 2005. He was a member of

St. Mary's Catholic Church in Pleasanton, the Pleasanton Legion and VFW and the Submarine Veterans of World War II.
