



## Barry G. Delaney

December 9, 1943 - July 27, 2014

Barry G. Delaney, 70, of Kearney, died Sunday, July 27, 2014 at the Good Samaritan Hospital in Kearney. Barry was cremated, and private family services will be held at a later date. Memorials are suggested to the family to be designated later. Horner Lieske McBride & Kuhl Funeral and Cremation Services in Kearney are in charge of arrangements.

Barry was born December 9, 1943 in Beloit, Kansas to Eugene and Erminie (Kresin) Delaney. The family moved to Oxford in 1946, where Barry graduated from high school in 1962. After school he started working in Kansas in the oil fields as a roughneck and a driller. Barry married Carman Coffey on August 21, 1965 at her home in Stamford, Nebraska. They lived in Cambridge until 1969 when they moved to Edison. In 1974 they moved to Oxford when they bought the Drive Inn. They sold the business in 1979, began farming until he retired in 2009. Barry and Carman then moved to Kearney. Barry enjoyed fishing and hunting, camping, and especially going to Harlan County Dam with his grandchildren to fish.
