Ben F. Fecht, 81, of Amherst, died Thursday, January 7, 2016 at Good Samaritan Society St. John's in Kearney. Funeral service will be Wednesday, January 13, 2016 at 10:00 a.m. at the Riverdale Christian Church with Pastor Scott Guthrie officiating. Burial will be at Bainbridge Cemetery in Huntley, Nebraska.
