There she worked for the Office of Defense Transportation. After the war, she and Floyd lived in Georgia, Nebraska, Colorado, Illinois, and Missouri, while Floyd taught school and obtained his Masters and Doctorate Degrees. While in Columbia, Missouri, she worked in the University of Missouri Music Department. In 1955 they moved to Kearney where Floyd accepted a job at Kearney State College. She worked at the Kearney Chamber of Commerce office. Betty was a member of the First Christian Church, Christian Women's Fellowship, UNK Faculty Wives, and PEO Chapter FN. She was a past member of the Nebraska Chamber of Commerce Assistants, Kearney State College Alumni Board, and two bridge clubs.
