Beverly "Bev" J. Neuheisel, 71, of Kearney, died Sunday, February 27, 2022 at her home in Kearney surrounded by loved ones. Mass of Christian Burial will be 10:30 am, March 4, 2022 at St. James Catholic Church with Fr. Joe Hannappel officiating. Burial will be at the Kearney Cemetery.
