Carol M. Sanders, 86, of Kearney, local artist passed away, Saturday, October 10, 2015 at Ravenna Good Samaritan Center. Memorial services will be Thursday, October 15, 2015 at 2:00 p.m. at Horner Lieske McBride & Kuhl Funeral and Cremation Services in Kearney with Pastor Dean Pofahl officiating. Carol was born January 18, 1929 in Kearney to Vern and Verna (Kelsey) Gard. She graduated from Kearney High School in 1947. Carol married Sid Sanders on July 28, 1950 in Denver, Colorado. As the mother of an Army family, she traveled all over the world- from Japan to Okinawa to Germany, France, and Italy. The family actually lived in Germany for three years as well as many duty stations in the continental United States, including Fort McClellan, Alabama and Rocky Mountain Arsenal in Denver where Sid was the Dep. Carol's sister, a prominent pastel painter-painting under the name Virginia Johnson is also active in the arts. Her sons will remember her as a great Mom, an absolutely wonderful cook, and the main source of strength that kept the family together all these years. She will be missed.
