Catherine M. "Kae" Dwiggin, 87, died Friday, November 21, 2014 at her home in Kearney.

On November 23, 1947 she married Daniel Dwiggin in Ulysses. She and her

husband lived on a farm north of Gibbon, NE and she taught Kindergarten in Gibbon for 34 years until retiring in 1987. They lived at Johnson Lake for 10 years and have lived in Kearney since 2000.

She was a member of First United Methodist Church in Kearney, Charter member of chapter HR of PEO in Gibbon, Eastern Star, Gamma Phi Beta and the D.A.R.
