Charlene J. Woolley, 58, of Kearney, died Saturday, April 27, 2019 at CHI Health Good Samaritan after a courageous battle with cancer. Funeral services will be 11:00 AM, Wednesday, May 1, 2019 at Countryside Christian Church with Minister Jeff Nielsen officiating. Burial will follow at the Kearney Cemetery. In high school she placed 2nd in Nebraska's Future Business Leaders of America shorthand competition and got to travel to nationals in San Francisco. After graduation she worked at Rockwell International in the flow control division where she certified valves. Starting in 1985, Charlene began working for West Pharmaceuticals in the office and she worked there for 33 years holding many different positions. She was a hard worker with great attention to detail and her co-workers were a second family to her. She was a member of Countryside Christian Church. Charlene enjoyed

being with her family, and her Siamese cats which she considered her children, traveling and listening to rock and roll bands, especially her favorite, Motley Crue.

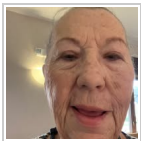
