Charles H. "Chuck" Beatty, age 78, of Kearney died Friday, March 5, 2010 in Kearney. Charles was born January 12, 1932 in Lincoln, Nebraska to Robert and J. Esther (Labert) Beatty. Chuck's father passed away at an early age. His mother then married Henry Bauer who raised him. Chuck lettered in track, basketball, and football, graduating from Holdrege High School in 1949. He joined the Army Air Corps on July 4, 1954 and was assigned to the 82nd Airborne Division, flying Cessna L 19 "Bird Dogs" as an aerial fire observer. He married Gertrude Carey on October 30, 1954 in Overton. After the Army he returned to Lincoln and graduated from the University of Nebraska College of Law in 1959. He moved to Kearney where he served as Deputy Buffalo County Attorney, a member of the Nebraska Aeronautics Commission, and practiced law for many years. Charles was a member of the Nebraska Bar Association for 50 years, and was instrumental in local service work with 12 step organizations.
