



## Clarence G. Cafferty

December 21, 1929 - January 14, 2018

Clarence G. Cafferty, 88, Kearney, formerly of Long Pine, died Sunday, January 14, 2018 at the Mother Hull Home in Kearney. Memorial services will be 10:30 am, January 18, 2018 at Faith United Methodist Church with Pastor Robert Perry officiating. Burial will follow at Kearney Cemetery. Clarence was born December 21, 1929 to Chester and Laura (Hampson) Cafferty in Cheyenne, Wyoming. He grew up in Kearney and graduated from Kearney High School in 1948. Clarence married Elsie Shuck on November 11, 1951 in Holdrege, and they later divorced. In 1975 Clarence moved to Long Pine, Nebraska, where he was involved in agri-business as well as a partner, owner operator of fertilizer corporations until retiring in 1992. He returned to his home town of Kearney in 2013 to be near family. He was a lifelong member of Faith United Methodist Church. Clarence was a 60 year member of the Rob Morris Masonic Lodge, the Tuscan Chapter of Eastern Star, Tehama Shriners, and the York Rite. Clarence was a retired member of the Army National Guard. He was also an avid Husker supporter.

Clarence is survived by his daughters, Lisa Robison and her husband Dave of Green River, WY, Marsha Nelson and her husband Dennis of Kearney; sister, Lorraine Mason of Kearney; grandchildren, Amy Heine, Gregory Heine and

his wife Janelle, Andrea Steffen and her husband Chris, Christie Heacock and her husband Tom, Carissa Crocker and her husband Nate, Casey Nelson and his wife Jacqueline; 13 great grandchildren.

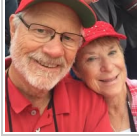
