He attended Barber School in Lincoln then on November 13, 1955 he married Phyllis Tuepker in Kearney. The couple lived in Kearney and he owned and operated Central Barber shop until retiring. Member of Zion Lutheran Church and was active with the Zion senior citizens group. He enjoyed reading, working crossword

puzzles and woodworking.
