Dale Ibsen, age 86, of Kearney, died Sunday, January 24, 2010 at the St. John's Good Samaritan Center in Kearney. Funeral service will be Thursday, January 28, 2010 at 10:30 A.M. at the First Lutheran Church in Kearney with Rev. Eric Lesher and Rev. Rebecca Craig officiating. Burial will be at the Kearney Cemetery. He was born February 9, 1923 to Lars and Marie (Rasmussen) Ibsen at their home South of Holdrege in Harlan County. He grew up in several farming communities. Dale attended grade school at District #8 in Phelps County and graduated from Atlanta, NE High School in 1940. He farmed with his father in Phelps and Harlan County. In 1942 Dale and his father drove a team of horses with all of their possessions to Buffalo County where Lars purchased farm ground North of Kearney. On May 18, 1946 Dale married Doris Walline in Norton, KS. They began their married life together on the farm North of Kearney. One of Dale's greatest joys was associating with the friends he made when he began his trucking business in the late 1970's. He was blessed with good health that allowed him to continue driving his truck until he was 82 years young. In 2006 he survived a scare with West Nile

Virus, and was determined to get back to work. He worked to live. Dale enjoyed playing baseball in Kearney and at Haven's Chapel where he played regularly until 1976. He also enjoyed watching baseball, waterfowl hunting, bowling, and playing cards. He loved spending time with his family. Family, Faith, Farming, and Fellowship were four cornerstones in his life. He was a member of the First Lutheran Church in Kearney for 65 years. Dale and Doris would have celebrated their 64th wedding Anniversary in May.
