Darold M. Halliwell, age 89, of Odessa, died Tuesday, December 16, 2014 at the Good Samaritan Hospital in Kearney.

Funeral services will be Monday, December 22, 2014 at 10:30 a.m. at Holy Cross Lutheran Church in Kearney with Pastor Dustin Lappe and Pastor Duane Duley officiating. Darold was a veteran of WWII and entered the service on September 25, 1946 and served in the U.S. Marine Corp until he was discharged on September 2, 1948. He married Norma Van Cleave and they divorced. He later married Arlene Cooper on January 19, 1973 in Lexington. He grew up in Odessa, moved to Kearney in 1974 and returned to Odessa in 1985. He was employed as a millworker and also farmed for Loren Knapp, ADM Mills and Carl Weber. He retired in 2006. He was a member of V.F.W. Post # 759 and a past member of the Eagles Lodge. He enjoyed horses and dogs and was an avid collector of ball caps and hats with a collection of over 3,000 hats. He loved spending time with family and friends.

Surviving relatives include son, Keith Halliwell and his wife Cheryl of Kearney; daughter in law, Cathy Labs and her husband Don of Odessa; daughter in law, Sue Halliwell of Elm Creek; two sisters, Fern Shea and Dot Chavanu both of Kearney; 14 grandchildren, 2 step grandchildren and 18 great grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by his wife Arlene on June 3, 2013, 3 sons Gary, Ron and Don and one brother Harry.
