Delores J. Reese, 83 of Ravenna, formerly of Pleasanton, died Saturday, March 7, 2015 at the Good Samaritan Society in Ravenna. Funeral services will be Wednesday, March 11, 2015 at 10:30 a.m. at the Pleasanton United Methodist Church with Rev. Marta Wheeler officiating. Burial will be at the Pleasanton Cemetery. Visitation will be Tuesday, March 10, 2015 from 5:00 to 7:00 p.m. at the Horner Lieske McBride & Kuhl Funeral and Cremation Services in Kearney, and one hour prior to the service Wednesday at the church in Pleasanton.
