Dolores C. Adelung, 92, of Kearney, NE died Monday, February 2, 2026, at Brookestone Gardens in Kearney. Funeral services will be 11:00 am, February 7, 2026, at Good Shepherd Lutheran Church. Private family burial will be held at a later date. Visitation will be from 4:00 to 6:00 pm, February 6, 2026, at Horner Lieske McBride & Kuhl Funeral and Cremation Services and one hour prior to the service. Dolores (Dee) Charlene Adelung was born on January 1, 1934, in Custer County, NE to Virginia (Willard) and Charles Hutchins, as the eldest of three siblings.

Dolores was united in marriage with Roland Adelung on December 31, 1954. To this union were born three children: Pam, Perry, and Les. Roland and Dolores farmed north of Miller, NE near the South Loup River during the early part of their marriage. They milked cows, raised hogs and cattle, and grew corn on Seraphine Willard's Milton Store acreage. In 1966, the family moved to Broken Bow, NE. Dolores worked at several businesses in Broken Bow including the Becton-Dickenson Plant, Ben Franklin 5-10 Store, the City Café, and the Elks Club. She made and sold cinnamon rolls with Roland in their retirement in Broken Bow. Roland and Dolores moved to Kearney, NE in 2007.

Dolores was member of the Good Shepherd Evangelical Lutheran Church in Kearney, NE.

Dolores is survived by daughter, Pam Riggins of Kearney, sons, Perry (Jo Dee) Adelung of Merriam, KS, Les Adelung of Amherst; seven grandchildren, Rachael Carpenter (Justin Kelly), Jenifer Koehn, Jo Ella (Brian) Hoye, Ann Dee (Ben) Tucker, Trevor Adelung, Riley Adelung, and Austin Adelung; five great grandchildren, Skylar, Presley, William, Perri, and Stanley; brother, Ron (Cassandra) Hutchins; and sister, Vilene Cherry.
