Donald E. Emrick, age 77, of Kearney, passed away Monday, February 16, 2026 at Kearney Regional Medical Center. Funeral Liturgy (Outside of Mass) will be 10:30 a.m., Friday, February 20, 2026 at Prince of Peace Catholic Church with Father Scott Harter officiating. Inurnment will follow at 3:00 p.m., that Friday at Fort McPherson National Cemetery near Maxwell, with military honors graveside, and Pastor Jonathan Lumbard officiating from Spirit of Life Church. Donald (Don) Eugene Emrick was born on July 11, 1948, in Lancaster, OH to Ila Kathleen Emrick and Donald Eugene Nichols. He was the only child of this union. He was raised in Lancaster, OH and joined the United States Navy at the age of 17. During his service, he was stationed in Corpus Christi, Texas, where he loved flying and assisting with aircraft landings as a crewman aboard an aircraft carrier. Following his military service, Don earned his associate degree from Hocking Technical College. Shortly thereafter, he began his career with the United States Fish and Wildlife Service, dedicating his professional life to conservation and the outdoors.

Don was united in marriage with Catherine (Cathy) Joos on June 12, 1971.

Two children were born to this union, Bryan and Angela. In the early years of their marriage, Don and Cathy moved as he pursued his career. They lived in Texas, where both of their children were born, and later in Valentine, NE, where Don worked and the family lived on the wildlife refuge. In 1989, they made their permanent home in Kearney, NE.

Don was an avid naturalist who had a deep appreciation for the many species of trees and birds he encountered throughout his life. His pride and joy was a 35-year old non-native American Beech tree that he nurtured from a sapling, which is a rare find west of the Missouri River Valley. He was a master woodworker who took immense pride in his craftsmanship, a passion that carried over to his garden, where he was known for growing abundant crops of watermelon and popcorn every summer. He was a devoted, daily student of scripture and was an active member of the Spirit of Life Church in Kearney.

Don is survived by his beloved wife of 55 years this June, Cathy; his son, Bryan (Jessica) Emrick of Colorado Springs, CO; his daughter, Angela (Travis) Hollman of Gibbon, NE; and eight grandchildren, Madyson, Sterling, Parker, Marcus, Ayla, Logan, Nathan, and Emmalynn; brother Craig Nichols of Cheyenne, WY; his uncle, Phil Emrick of Lancaster, OH, and many cousins in Ohio.

Don is preceded in death by his parents.
