Donna M. Larson, 90, of Brookings, SD formerly of Kearney, died peacefully on Sunday, January 14, 2018 at the Edgewood Vista Care Center in Brookings. Shortly after Richard's death on Dec. 29, 1998, Donna moved to Northridge Retirement Community in Kearney where she resided until August 2017. At Northridge she had a loving, 5-year friendship with Bruce Morris. Bruce passed away in 2014. Donna's last several months were spent at Edgewood Vista in Brookings where she received wonderful care while close to family.

After graduating high school, Donna worked as a bookkeeper at Farmers

Union Elevator in Grand Island. She later worked as a long distance telephone operator, beginning at Bell Telephone in Grand Island and for many more years at General Telephone in Kearney. She retired from GT&E in 1985 after 32 years of service.

Donna's love for family and friends was measurable in food calories. She was exceptionally accomplished as a baker of a fantastic array of delicious cakes, pies, rolls, and cookies. Her platters of Christmas cookies and candies were looked forward to every year.
