Doris M. Moomey, 90, of Kearney died Tuesday, April 14, 2015 at Emeritus North Ridge Place in Kearney.

Following the war Doris was reunited with her high school sweetheart Bill and they were married on August 28, 1946. Eventually the couple moved to the family farm near Sumner where they raised their family.

Doris' faith was very important to her. She was an active member of the First

Baptist Church in Sumner before moving to Kearney where she quickly became involved in the life of the First Baptist Church there.
