Doyle A. Watson, 80, of Kearney, formerly of Arapahoe, died Sunday, August 20, 2017 at CHI Health – Good Samaritan Hospital in Kearney. Doyle was a part owner of Watson Mueller and Jones, a farm implement dealership in Arapahoe from 1968 until 1985. He later farmed in the Arapahoe area. He married Ethel Meyer in 1960 and two sons were born to this union; Todd A. and Tedd H. They later divorced and he married Mary Jane (Roth) Breinig on November 9, 2010 in Kearney, NE. Doyle was a member of the First United Methodist Church in Kearney. He enjoyed playing and watching athletics and especially enjoyed watching his grandchildren compete in their various athletic activities. An athlete himself, Doyle still holds basketball

records for scoring at Arapahoe High School. He greatly enjoyed a round of golf and was known as an avid card player.
