Esther E. Jameson, age 83, of Amherst, died Monday, January 24, 2011 at her home. She attended school at District #74, Prairie Dell and Parochial School at Immanuel Lutheran Church. After her schooling she stayed home and helped with the housework and cared for her mother. She attended Walther League activities, and worked at Mother Hull Home for a short period of time. She married the love of her life James Norman Jameson on August 15, 1954 at Immanuel Lutheran Church

north of Amherst. They lived on and farmed his dad's place northeast of Amherst. With growing up on the farm and now a new farm wife she assisted with farm chores including raising chickens, milking cows, raising pigs and feeding hogs and cattle, gardening, canning, baking, cooking, sewing, and crocheting. She was a hard worker devoted to taking care of her family (children and grandchildren). Esther was a member of the Immanuel Lutheran Church, Trinity Lutheran Church, HOP Club, and a choir member of both churches. She enjoyed playing cards, quilting, traveling with her husband, and listening to music especially original Carter family and Johnny Cash, country and western, and several of the local performers.
