



## Fred H, Gleason

June 13, 1950 - December 9, 2025

Fred H. Gleason, 75, of Kearney, died December 9, 2025, at C.H.I. Health Good Samaritan Hospital in Kearney. Funeral services will be 10:30 am, December 22, 2025, at Holy Cross Lutheran Church in Kearney. Private family burial will take place at a later date. Viewing will be from 3:00 to 5:00 pm, December 21, 2025, at Horner Lieske McBride & Kuhl Funeral and Cremation Services. In lieu of flowers, Memorials are suggested to St. John's Lutheran Church in Brule, Nebraska or Peace Lutheran Church in McCook, Nebraska.

Fred was born June 13, 1950, in Norfolk, Nebraska to Irvin and Verona (Saeger) Gleason. He grew up in Pierce, Nebraska and attended Zion Lutheran School and graduated from Pierce High School in 1968. He continued his education while participating in basketball at Northeast Community College and received his bachelor's degree from Wayne State College. He then obtained a Master's in Education from University of Nebraska at Lincoln. He later continued his education and completed an Education Specialist degree from University of Nebraska at Kearney.

On August 11, 1973, Fred was united in marriage to Debra Kaye Fullner at Zion Lutheran Church in Pierce, Nebraska. They were married for 52 years and from their union they had two children, a son, David and a daughter, Kim. They made their home for 18 years in Brule, NE where they raised their children. They relocated to McCook, NE in 2004, and most recently moved to

Kearney, NE in October 2024 to be closer to family.

For forty-three years, Fred worked in education throughout Nebraska. He had a passion for coaching basketball and volleyball during his career. He retired as a Guidance Counselor from McCook High School in 2018.

There were two things that Fred said he could not live without, God's love and family. He was an active member in his church community serving for many years. He felt that Faith should be simple and uncluttered, because that is the way God wants it. Fred valued the time he was able to spend with his family. He could be found at many family gatherings playing cards and sharing words of wisdom with his children and grandchildren. He also enjoyed golfing, working in the garden, and reading. He was a loyal Pierce Bluejay and Nebraska Cornhusker fan throughout his life. He rarely missed an opportunity to watch either team and then later discussed the games with friends and family.

Fred is survived by his wife, Deb Gleason of Kearney, NE, son, David (Becky) Gleason of Hutchinson, KS, daughter, Kim (Bryan) Seitler of Kearney, NE, grandchildren, Madalyn Gleason, Garrett Gleason, Wyatt Gleason, Gabrielle Gleason, Christian Seitler, Kirsten Seitler, and Emersyn Seitler.

Fred was preceded in death by his parents, one brother and two sisters.
