Gail H. Robart, age 92, of Lincoln, Formerly of Shelton, died Wednesday, April 3, 2013 at the Country House Residence in Lincoln. After graduating from Snyder High School, he served in the CCC until 1940. On December 17, 1941 he married Ruth Peterson from Oakland, NE. He was drafted into the Army Air Corp in July 1942. He was assigned to the 868 Heavy Bombardment Squadron, 13th Air Corp and served in Okinawa and the Philippines during WWII until he was discharged in early 1946. He worked for the Social Security Administration in North Platte, Nebraska, where his two sons were born and Norfolk, Nebraska until his retirement in 1975. He moved to Shelton, Nebraska in 1992 and was a member of Holy Cross Lutheran Church Kearney, Nebraska and the American Legion in Shelton. He was able to enjoy spending his winters in Brownsville, TX until 2011. Surviving relatives include his sons, William Robart and his wife Karen of Shelton, NE and Robert Robart and his wife Cheryl of Lincoln, NE; Sister, Gloria Smith of Fremont, NE; 5 Grandchildren (from all over the world) and 13 Great Grandchildren. Gail was preceded in death by his wife, Ruth; 1 brother and 2 sisters.
