He was a past member of the Kearney Elks Lodge # 984, Kiwanis and the Kearney Volunteer Fire Department. Gary served as director, Secretary, Vice President and President of the Nebraska Chapter of the American Public Works Association (APWA). He was a Board member appointed by the Governor of Nebraska for the highway and County superintendent license for first class cities. He was an advisory board member of the Nebraska LTAP. Gary was instrumental in starting the Nebraska chapter of the Snow Plow Rodeos.
