George T. Richardson, 99, of Kearney died Thursday, September 20, 2012 at the Good Samaritan Hospital in Kearney. Graveside services will be Monday at 2:00 p.m. at the Kearney Cemetery. Rev. George was born October 2, 1912 in Kansas City, MO to Halfred Dewey and Clara Pauline (Thompson) Richardson. He graduated from Kearney High School and then Kearney State Teacher's College. He taught at a rural sandhills School, Chadron Grade School, then taught at Pennsylvania Military Academy in Philadelphia where he was a physics instructor. While in Pennsylvania he earned his pilot's license. He joined the U.S. Army Air Corps where he served during WWII from 1942 – 1944. After the war he moved back to Kearney where he farmed. On April 21, 1961 he married Ilene Pinn in Kearney. They made their home on an acreage along the Platte River. George attended many farm auctions over his years in Kearney and was known as 'Uncle George'" or #99, his auction number he always used. He was a direct descendant of the famous Admiral Dewey. He

was a supporter of the Goodfellows in Kearney and he and Ilene loved and raised many animals on the homestead over the years. He was a one time member of the Philadelphia Methodist Church and the Kearney United Methodist Church.
