Glenn E. Vest, age 83, of Harborcreek Township, PA passed away Sunday, February 27, 2011 at the St. Vincent Health Center. Glenn was a Professional Engineer and belonged to the American Society of Mechanical Engineers and the Quarter Century Club of G.E. He enjoyed hunting, fishing, target shooting and was active in model airplanes. He also liked square dancing and was a member of the Squaws and Paws Square dancing club, Presque Isle Dancers, Perry Squares, and Penn Shores Dance Club. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his wife, Lucile Loeffelholz Vest in 2007 and by two brothers, Walter and Richard Vest. Survivors include two sons, Douglas Vest, wife Doris of Erie

and Joseph Vest, wife Kellie of Ft. Walton Beach, Fl; a daughter, Evelyn Wedzikowski, husband John of Erie; eight grandchildren, John and Jennifer Wedzikowski, Scott Vest, wife Ashley and Andrew Vest, Jorden, Tayler and Nicole Vest and Joey Vest Jr.; great grandchildren, Cayden Vest, Nilyne Vest and Christine Rodriguez.
