Glenn D. Kegley, 90, of Kearney died Wednesday, July 24, 2019 at Mt. Carmel Home and Rehabilitation Center in Kearney.

He was a long-time member of Haven's Chapel United Methodist Church and is currently a member of First United Methodist Church in Kearney. He had served on the Thorton Township Board, District 35 School Board and was a 4-H Club Leader. He and his wife enjoyed dancing at Miller on Saturday nights.
