She would tell stories of the young people working at Eatons or Baldwins. One of our favorite

stories is how the ladies would cook meals for young working students to help them balance work and school. The ladies had fun even with the hardships they encountered. She made many friends and cherished all of them. She was a Girl Scout leader and active in her children's elementary school. While working she raised her children and became a part of the large Vasquez family.

Her true calling was to be at the side of her husband, Raul Vasquez. Together they worked through a life of hard work, family, traveling, raising children and their devotion to each other. This is a story of true love. They each had their commitments to organizations or hobbies, but the one commitment that would never end was their commitment and love for each other.

Gloria spent her latter part of her life helping people either through St. James Church or through friends. Gloria loved her church, she would always talk about Father Joe, Father Art, Father Mike any of the priests at the church she would befriend. With their help she led the organization of the bi-lingual mass and singing. She loved to sing. You could always see her singing in the choir. During the holidays she volunteered her children to ring the bell for the Salvation Army. She and Raul and their children also helped to deliver food to people in need or organizations. Gloria gave of her time and her gifts in any way she could.

She was proud of her son, Nick who served the Army, as an Army Ranger and was proud when her grandsons: Jonathon, Joseph and Uriah followed by joining the Navy, and Army. Faithfully, she honored the Military by decorating for the 4th of July and participating in the events for Memorial Day.

Gloria's love for God, people, her glowing smile and laughter will be deeply missed. We love you mom. I wish you could stay but I know it is time for you to go and be with the Lord. Please save a spot for me as someday I will be
