H. Dean Shultz, 92, of Kearney, died March 22, 2025, at the Central Nebraska Veterans Home in Kearney. Funeral services will be 10:30 am, April 1, 2025, at Horner Lieske McBride & Kuhl Funeral Chapel with Michael Koenig officiating. Burial with Military Rites will follow the service at Kearney Cemetery. Visitation will be one hour prior to the service at the funeral home. In retirement Dean became pastor and helped establish the Open Door Fellowship Church in Gibbon retiring again in 2012.
