Harold P. Debban, 92, of Kearney, died December 29, 2023 at Good Samaritan Society – St. John’s in Kearney. Funeral services will be 10:30 am, January 3, 2024 at Holy Cross Lutheran Church in Kearney with Pastor John Rasmussen officiating. Burial with Military Rites provided by the Nebraska National Guard Funeral Honors Team, Kearney American Legion Post #52, and Kearney V.F.W. Post #759 will follow the service at Kearney Cemetery. Visitation will be from 4:00 to 6:00 pm, January 2, 2024 at Horner Lieske McBride & Kuhl Funeral and Cremation Services and one hour prior to the service at the church. Harold married Eileen Brand May 20, 1956 in Elwood. They lived in Kearney, where Harold worked as an electronic technician for Rockwell International and Baldwin Manufacturing until he retired in 1995.

He enjoyed woodworking - making toys, painting pictures, camping, traveling, and was active in bible studies throughout his life. He was a member of Holy

Cross Lutheran Church in Kearney.
