Harvey R. Winslow, 64, of Kearney, died November 9, 2021 at St. Francis Medical Center in Grand Island, Nebraska. Memorial Mass will be 10:30 am, November 12, 2021 at St. James Catholic Church with Fr. Art Faesser officiating. Inurnment will follow the service at Kearney Cemetery. Harvey was born in Kearney September 5, 1957 to Maurice and Marjorie (Turner) Winslow. He graduated from Kearney High School in 1975 and continued his education at Hastings Community College graduating with an associate degree in diesel mechanics.
