Helen M. Glatter, 88, of Amherst, died Sunday, April 27, 2014 at the Good Samaritan Hospital in Kearney. Mass of Christian Burial will be Friday, May 2, 2014 at 10:30 am at the St. James Catholic Church in Kearney with Fr. Jose Chavez, Fr. Joe Hannappel, and Fr. Alex Brozych officiating. Burial will be at the Kearney Cemetery.
