Ilene J. Anson, 68, Kearney, passed away February 21, 2018 at C.H.I. Health Good Samaritan Hospital in Kearney. A Memorial Mass will be 10:30 a.m., February 27, 2018 at St. James Catholic Church with Fr. Art Faesser officiating. Burial will follow at the Kearney Cemetery. Memorials are suggested to the Good Samaritan Foundation – Animal Assisted Therapy or the Kearney Area Animal Shelter.

Ilene was born October 13, 1949 in Scottsbluff, Nebraska to Emmet and Ruth (Mead) Davidshofer. She graduated from Bayard High School in 1967. She earned her B.S. in Education from Kearney State College in 1971, and then her Master's Degree from UNK in 2003.

Ilene married Gerald Anson on December 22, 1972 in Kearney at the Newman Center. She spent 24 years in Broken Bow raising her family. She later divorced and spent her remaining years of life in Kearney.

Ilene worked as a case worker for Mid Nebraska Individual Services in Broken Bow for many years. She also taught math in Broken Bow, North Platte, and Kearney. The majority of her teaching career was at YRTC, and she retired in 2014.

Ilene enjoyed volunteering at Good Samaritan Hospital, especially doing pet

therapy with her beloved dog Roscoe and at the Kearney Area Animal Shelter. She also enjoyed traveling and spending time with her grandchildren and attending their events. Ilene was a member of St. James Catholic Church.

Ilene is survived by her daughter, Beckie Uelmen and her husband John of Kearney; son, Darrin Anson and his wife Tami of Longmont, CO; grandchildren, Kade, Whitney, and Blake Uelmen of Kearney, and Holly, Abbie, and Lucas Anson of Longmont, CO; sister Luci Steffen and her husband Jon of Bayard, NE; and dear friend John Murphy of Kearney.

Ilene was preceded in death by her parents.

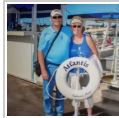
