Inez H. Dittmar, 100, of Kearney and formerly of Sumner, died Monday, April 20, 2015 at the CHI Health Good Samaritan in Kearney.

She moved to the St. John's Center to be with Arnold in 1998 and lived there until 2004 when she moved to Homestead Assisted Living where she resided until her death.

Inez was the last living charter member of the Grace Lutheran Church in Sumner where she was still a faithful member.
