He worked several years on the home ranch and for other ranchers in the area. He also worked as a lumberjack in the Chadron/Crawford, Nebraska

area. From there he went to Casper Wyoming to work in the oil fields. After that he moved to Kearney, Nebraska and worked at Rockwell as a Machine Tool Operator and later a CNC programmer until Rockwell closed their doors. He then moved to Bradshaw NE to work at Sunstrand until his retirement in 1969.

After retirement, Ivan made his home in Riverdale Nebraska.

He was a member of the United Nebraska Muzzleloaders Association and a life member of the NRA.

He enjoyed reading, attending auctions, having coffee with close friends and sharing his life experiences with others. He was a wealth of information on many topics. His knowledge of firearms and their history was extensive. He enjoyed sharing that with the 4-H members. He enjoyed attending the UNMLA conventions and rendezvous and connecting with friends.
