Jay G. Lumbard, age 79, of Kearney, passed away Wednesday, April 8, 2020 at CHI Health – Good Samaritan Hospital in Kearney. 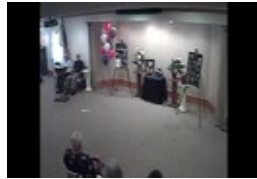

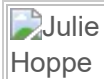
