Jeff S. Ingram, 42, of Kearney, died Wednesday, September 17, 2014 at the CHI Health Systems Saint Francis Medical Center in Grand Island as the result of an accident. Mass of Christian Burial will be Monday, September 22, 2014 at 10:30 a.m. at the St. James Catholic Church with Fr. Joe Hannappel officiating. Visitation will be Sunday, September 21, 2014 from 4:00 to 5:00 pm at the St. James Catholic Church with a wake service at 5:00 p.m. at the church. Memorials are suggested to the family to establish an education fund for his children. Military Rites will be provided at the church United States Navy funeral honors team, Kearney American Legion Post #52, and the Kearney V.F.W. Post #759.

Jeff was born October 18, 1971 in Kearney to Don and Cecilia (Keough) Ingram. He grew up in Kearney and graduated from Kearney High School in 1990. Jeff joined Navy after graduation.
