Jennifer was homeschooled for four years and then attended elementary school at the Kissimmee Methodist Church. The family later moved to Conyers, Georgia where she attended Heritage High School. She took classes at Clayton State University for two years before discontinuing due to her illnesses.

Jennifer lived up to her middle name, Joy! She enjoyed life and was a ray of sunshine to everyone she met. Her smile and laugh were contagious. She also loved to shop. From an early age she was drawn to glitter, pretty clothes,

purses, and shoes. Jennifer had a passion for sports and young children. She especially enjoyed her jobs as a promoter with the Atlanta Braves and Atlanta Hawks. Afterward, when the family moved to Owasso, Oklahoma, she coached young children in volleyball, soccer and basketball at the YMCA in Tulsa.

Jennifer is survived by her parents, Morris and Brenda Stover of Owasso, Oklahoma; brother Andrew and wife Cindy of Spiez, Switzerland; sister Mollie and husband Taylor Friesen of Lincoln, Nebraska; grandparents, Floyd and Pat Butterfield of Kearney, Nebraska; as well as many aunts, uncles, cousins, and friends. 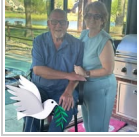
