Joy D. Clark, age 97, of Hutchinson, Kansas, formerly, of Miller died September 21, 2010 at the in Hutchinson. Joy was born April 29, 1913 in Miller to George F. and Daisy (Wells) Day. They were early pioneers of Buffalo County. The Day family lived north of Miller near Grandview School. Joy was the ninth child of a family of ten children. She attended Grandview Grade School and graduated from Miller High School in 1932. After high school, she worked at the Miller Telephone Central Office. She married Merle Clark on March 7, 1936 in Kearney. They lived on several rented farms getting their start in those depression years. In 1943, they bought the Jack Clark farm south of Miller and lived there raising livestock and farming until 1970. On retirement they moved to Kearney and lived there until 2006. After Merle's death in 1993, Joy continued to live in Kearney until she had a stroke and could no longer live alone. Joy spent the last four years of

her life as a resident of Mennonite Manor in South Hutchinson, Kansas to be near her daughter, Linda. She was member of the Miller Christian Church since 1946. After they moved to Kearney they attended Countryside Christian Church for many years. Merle and Joy were also members of Miller Senior Citizens. She will be greatly missed by her children, grandchildren, and other relatives and friends. She lived a long full life of 97 years, 4 months, and 23 days.
