Kenneth "Ken" C. Barth, 73, Kearney, died Sunday, November 8, 2015 at C.H.I. Health Good Samaritan Hospital in Kearney. Funeral services will be Thursday, November 12, 2015 at 10:30 a.m. at the First Baptist Church with Pastor Stan Murdoch officiating, and burial at Kearney Cemetery.
