Larry W. Houtz, 76, of Kearney, died Wednesday, June 7, 2017 at the Mother Hull Home in Kearney. Funeral services will be Monday, June 12, 2017 at 10:30 a.m. at the Kearney Church of Christ with Mr. Greg Clark officiating. Entombment will be in the mausoleum at Kearney Cemetery. He was a graduate of Madrid High School in 1958 where he was also an outstanding athlete. Larry attended college at Kearney State Teachers College. He was married to Judith "Judy" M. Ourada on December 20, 1959 and after his graduation from college with a Bachelor of Science Degree in Education in 1962, they moved to Venango, NE where Larry taught from 1962-1965. He then taught in Ravenna from 1965-1966 and Chappell from 1966-1968 when they moved to Kearney. Larry received his Masters Degree in Counseling in 1966 and taught and was a counselor in the Kearney Public School system from 1968 until he retired in 2000. Larry was a member of the Kearney Church Of Christ, Friends Program (Big Brothers and Big Sisters) and the Crisis Team for the Kearney Public Schools. He was instrumental in starting the 9th grade girls basketball

program. He also enjoyed fishing, stamp collecting and was a train enthusiast. Larry was an avid reader, especially of James Michener novels. Larry is survived by his wife Judy of Kearney; son, Doug Houtz and his wife Cindy of Kearney; 3 daughters, Sandra "Sandy" Sitter and her husband Steve, Jane Parrett and her husband Brent, and Linda Parker and her husband Joel all of Edmond, Oklahoma; grandchildren, Jenna and Kristen Sitter, David and Rachel Parrett, Sarah and Preston Parker of Edmond, OK and Danielle Houtz and Sarah Jensen and her husband Dru of Kearney; great grandchildren, Tate and Dylan Straatmann of Kearney; brother, Glen Houtz and his wife Kathi of Lincoln and brother in law, Dan Spelts of Arlington, TX.
