Even though she was burdened with this diagnosis she always remained positive, knowing that either outcome of the transplant would give her a win-win situation she would either beat the cancer and get more time with her family or she would finally meet Jesus face to face. She didn't have just one favorite Bible verse, but rather many, but one that stood out during this earthly trial was "the joy of

the Lord is my strength”.

In the words of verse 5 of Amazing Grace, “Yea, when this flesh and heart shall fail, and mortal life shall cease, I shall possess within the veil, A life of joy and peace.”

Laura Ruth Deets was born on August 14th, 1957 at St. Francis in Grand Island, NE to Lloyd and Barbara (Smith) Dietrich. She was baptized as an infant at EUB church in Aurora, NE. She attended Marquette school in Marquette, Nebraska and graduated from Marquette High School in 1975. Laura was married to Tom J.R. Deets on July 10th 1975 at EUB church in Aurora, NE. She was a supportive wife, mother, grandmother, and friend. Her children and granddaughters were her pride and joy.
