LaVonne W. Adamson Rosenow, 91, of Kearney, died Saturday, February 19, 2011 at Mt. Carmel Home in Kearney. Funeral services will be Wednesday, February 23, 2011 at 11:00 a.m. at the Evangelical Free Church in Kearney. Rev. Mike Shields will officiate. Visitation is planned prior to services Wednesday at the church. Further services will be in Dinuba, CA and burial will be at the Smith Mountain Cemetery in Dinuba. Growing up in Sioux City, IA, she graduated from East High School and then attended Morningside College for 1 year. Her family moved to San Diego, CA where she graduated from San Diego State University in 1942. She was a credentialed school teacher and taught briefly in Wilmington, CA. She also worked as a secretary for Consolidated Aircraft in San Diego during WWII. She married John A. Adamson on May 27th, 1950 in Glendale, CA. The couple lived in Bakersfield and then Dinuba, CA where they established his medical practice and raised their family. Her husband died in 1984. In 1989, she married Edward C. Rosenow, of Philadelphia, PA, where they lived until moving to Kearney in 2001. Dr. Rosenow then died in June of 2002. She valued her Christian faith, attending Trinity Presbyterian Church and the Evangelical Free Church in Kearney. A member of the D.A.R., she

enjoyed politics and was a member of the Kearney Republicans .
